Devil (about the wily tempter—verses compiled by God and Karen Wilder)

The devil, Satan, Lucifer; The destroyer Ps. 17:4; The avenger; a thief Prov. 6:30; an angel of light, the power of darkness; the prince of darkness; the accuser of the brethren; a demon, a liar, a prowling lion seeking whom he may devour. The prince of this world; the wicked one

Bad things have happened over and over in my life. Never connected it until my eyes were opened and I knew Him (Jesus). HE does me only GOOD! When I knew HIM, then I knew satan-the villain who does me only bad. If it's not good,

perfect, or excellent, it is not God, it is satan. Satan is behind all the bad that happens to you. Things happen over and over in my life—marriage 5 times-almost divorced; Never had A/C that worked; vehicles always something wrong—<u>have to go through things until we conquer them</u>. I had my faith in satan, <u>not God</u> in all the things that almost destroyed me. I was believing the enemy—He was such a bold-faced liar.

Doubt- satan gets us to doubt God and HIS WORD. The man who doubts in his faith receives nothing. Therefore, When we start believing God or make steps to turn to him, satan turns up the heat of the battle (things often get worse instead of better) this is to take away our faith. (God doesn't answer immediately-so we doubt). Believe-to take to be true or real.

...Let him ask in faith, nothing wavering (doubting), for he who wavers (doubts) is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double minded man, unstable in all his ways. James 1:6-7

Faith in God is a terrific venture in the dark; (so much easier to believe what we see with our eyes than what we can't see, the invisible God) We have to believe God is love despite all that contradicts it. Every soul represents some kind of <u>battlefield</u>. The great point for the Christian is to remain <u>perfectily confident in God</u>. seen vs. unseen- for we walk by <u>faith</u> not by sight; 2 Cor. 4:7

While we look not at things which are seen but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal. 2 Cor. 4:18.

All things, whatsoever, ye shall *ask in* prayer, <u>believing</u> ye shall receive. Matt 21:21-22

I <u>believe</u> you God—believe what doeth say the WORD of GOD.

Faith is <u>confidence</u> in GOD, the <u>assurance</u> GOD will do what HIS WORD says HE will do. Be <u>ye steadfast</u>, <u>unmovable</u>.

Faith is the only thing we take with us when we leave this world.

And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee. God in peace. Luke 7:50 ... I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no not in Israel. Luke 7:9 without faith it is impossible to please HIM, for he that cometh to God must believe that HE IS, and that HE IS a rewarder of them that diligently seek HIM. Heb. 11:6

<u>Faith acts on the unseen</u> (Pray for rain-umbrella)

(Faith makes us look like a fool in the eyes of the world)

Faith comes from looking at God, not at your circumstances (the mountain).

Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the WORD OF GOD.

Feed your faith and doubts will starve to death.

<u>RELEASE YOUR FAITH-</u> Jump and leap for joy! Luke 6:23; Laugh, dance, shout, sing. Take authority over satan-talk back to him.

Faith is the opposite of reasoning. Looking at impossible.

Faith-to faith-to faith

Believe God is willing and able to do anything and everything!

<u>Offended</u>- satan causes us to be hurt, he makes us angry or disappoints us—but uses people to do it.

People offend us; God offends us. Satan causes us to play the <u>Blame</u> game-Satan is the <u>accuser</u> of the brethren-we accuse everybody but the culprit-satan, We get mad, angry, harbor grudge, unforgiveness, hatred, bitterness. (When someone dies, we blame God-satan says God could have prevented it. We listen to satan the accuser. Satan steals, kills and destroys-We get mad at God or people but seldom Satan-the real demon. <u>Look past the person to the enemy behind their actions</u>. It is time to get mad at satan and be determined to take back what he is stealing.

Let every man be a liar but God the truth. JESUS is the WAY the TRUTH and the LIFE.

HE is not as man that HE can lie. things not what they appear; Moses-rod turned to snake; Pharoah wizards could do it too. Satan mimics God. He often appears as angel of light. It is so hard to know if it is God or satan at times. Does it line up with the WORD of GOD?

Blessed is He whosoever shall not be offended in me. Luke 7:23

But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves. Luke 7:30

And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offense toward God, and toward men. Acts 24:16 (Paul in prison)

We do unto others as they do unto us. We respond like the world. We are in a deserving, vindictive society; Make them pay!!! Satan says!

"An eye for eye and a tooth for a tooth make the whole world blind." Ghandi Our world so set on accountability-responsibility-make him pay-yet Jesus said to the woman caught in adultery- He that is without sin, let him cast the first stone. I came not into the world to condemn the world but that the world through me might be saved.

Every way of a man is right in his own eyes; but the Lord pondereth the heart. Proverbs 21:2

The <u>heart is deceitful above all things and</u> <u>desperately wicked.</u> Jer. 17:9

Say not, <u>I will do so to him as he hath done</u> to me; Prov: 24:29

Say not, I will recompense evil, but wait on the Lord and He shall save thee. Proverbs 20:22

Pride goeth before a fall.

Lest when thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein. <u>Business-rushed</u>. Satan has us too busy; hurried, in haste—too busy to pray or read the Bible, to busy for God. Rushing and hurrying around with more to do, no time to do it; We do not have time to act or think; Satan has us where he wants us.

When we pray we want the answer right now, we can't wait; If God doesn't answer immediately satan tell us God is not working; God is not going to answer. Satan is a liar. We do not have to do it now or have it now; We can wait
The thoughts of the diligent (steady, unhurried) tend only to plenteousness; but of every one that is hasty only to want.

Proverbs 21:5

Go not forth <u>hastily</u> to strive, lest thou know not what to do in the end thereof, when thy neighbor has put thee to shame. Prov. 25:8

If Jesus never got in a hurry, why should we? Lazarus was dead four days before Jesus went to see Mary and Martha. Jesus is often late in our time schedule but the Bible says His timing is perfect..

Now, it happened as they went that He

entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. And she had a sister called

Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her. Luke 10:38-42 We need to be patient and show selfcontrol. He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls. Prov 25:28 **Wait** on GOD-Do not do anything in haste; hurry is never of GOD. God will often require us to wait so that we know it is God who does it; God's timing is perfect. He also has us wait because in the waiting, He is making us just like His Son—He is changing us and those we are praying for; faith never gives up; never;

God's delays looks like God is doing nothing. Satan says God is doing nothing. Don't believe satan Each delay is perfectly fine, for we are within the safe arms of God as someone once said. Postponements are reasons to pray rather than grow anxious, impatient or annoyed. They are opportunities for God to change us and other to become more like Jesus; to built patience, humility, and strength in us. That they may know that it is thy hand; that thou hast done it. Psalm 109:27 Are there any among the vanities of the Gentiles that can cause rain? Or can the heaven's give showers? Art not thou HE, O Lord, our God? Therefore we will wait for thee; for thou has made all these things. Jeremiah 14:22 I the Lord search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, an according to the fruit of his doing.

Jeremiah 17:10

<u>Distraction</u> satan has us distracted with people, things and situations ie. phone, computer, addictions, TV-anything but GOD.

Most often when we try to talk to GOD, the phone rings, there is a knock on door etc. <u>Deadly D's-DOUBT</u>, DISCOURAGEMENT, DISTRACTION Keep your eyes on the Lord. Make time for HIM FIRST!

Depend on something other than God-We depend on people, things, our own abilities or our own resources, anything and everything but God. We tend to trust others for what we can only get from GOD. Satan has us full of independence and self-sufficiency. PRIDE in the Bible-lift oneself up above God-to discard God. We are so good, so independent we don't need HIM.

My soul wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him. See Ps. 135:15-18.

Give us help from trouble; for vain is the help of man. Psalm 108:12 The idols of the heathen are silver and gold, the work of men's hands. They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes they have but they see not; They have ears, but they hear not; neither is there any breath in their mouths. They that make them are like unto them; so is everyone that trusteth in them. Psalms 135:15-18 Whom have I in heaven but Thee? And there is none upon earth that I desire beside thee. Psalm 73:25 Generational patterns of behaviorgenerational curses-(the sins of our fathers fall on us). WE need to recognize the things that have come down to us and --draw the blood line. STOP curses now so they don't proceed to the next generation.

We have snares to deal with through our family tree.

Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? Then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil. Jeremiah 13:23 (We can't do it on our own power-takes Jesus to change hearts)

Disunity and isolation—discord. Satan wants us to have no friends; to be isolated. Remember there is strength in numbers. This is why satan can't stand unity—Two are better than one, a threefold chord is not easily broken. We are all one in Christ. We are one with our Savior. He is in us, we are in Him. We must abide—stay rooted and grounded-stay connected-not isolated and separated in our relationship with Christ and the Church and others.

The discretion of a man deferreth his anger, and it is his glory to pass over a transgression. Proverbs 19:11

Better is a dry morsel and quietness therewith, than a house full of sacrifices with strife. Proverbs 19:1
The beginning of strife is as when one letteth out water; therefore leave off contention, before it be meddleth with.

Proverbs 17:14

A fool's lips enter into <u>contention</u> and his mouth calls for <u>strokes</u>. Proverbs 18:6
The contentions of a wife are <u>a continual</u> <u>dripping</u>. Proverbs 19:13

It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop than with a <u>brawling woman</u> in a wide house. Proverbs 21:9

It is better to dwell I the wilderness, tan with a <u>contentious and an angry woman</u>. Proverbs 21:19

And every city <u>divided</u> against itself shall not stand. Matt. 12:25

God had a Son and He gave His Son so He could have a family. You and me!!!

Jesus didn't come to get us into heaven. He came to get heaven in us. My will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Judgmental-Big sins, little sins. Satan has us thinking there are big sins and little sins. There are no big sins and little sins in God's eyes; lying and hatred are the same as murder and adultery in God's book; they all separate us from God Are those Galatians sinners above all.Luke 13:1-9. Are my husband's sins worse than mine? We can often see the mote in someone else's eye (satan makes sure) but not the beam in our own eye. A critical or judgmental spirit are not from God but from satan.

We are never satisfied- We grumble and complain. We are ungrateful! (The grumbling Israelites spent 40 years going in circles in the wilderness because they would not obey God and do it God's

way!!!) Be content in whatsoever state you find yourself. Be at peace, rest in the Lord. Rejoice always!

Too tired, hungry, thirsty-too much indulgence, discouraged, hopeless - All of these are from satan.

But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and care of this life and that Day come on you unexpectantly. Luke 22:34

My brethren <u>count it all joy</u> when you fall into various trials. James 1:2

Disobedience, Go our own way- either in ignorance or willfully. There is a way they seemeth right unto a man but the ways thereof are the ways of death.

Beware that thou forget not the Lord thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day. Duet. 8:11

As the nations which the Lord destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of the LORD your GOD. Duet. 8:20. It has to be God's way or no way. He is the WAY!!

<u>Sickness-</u> often is oppression from satan. Satan wants to destroy us physically with sickness, addictions, stress, depression and mental illness. Satan wants us to believe God brings the illness and it is GOD's will for us to be ill. God allows satan to attack us with illness. GOD does not however cause illness. God gives good gifts; illness is not a good gift. I believe it is always GOD'S WILL FOR US TO BE HEALED. It is never God's will for us to be sick. When we pray if it is the Lord's will we have lost the battle of faith already because seeds of doubt are already painted from the start. There was a certain woman who had an infirmity 18 years and was bowed together.

And when Jesus saw her, he call her to him and said to her, Woman thou are loosed from thine infirmity. ...And He laid his hands on her and immediately she was made straight and glorified God. God tells us satan had bound the woman. WHOM SATAN HAD BOUND. Luke 13:12, 16 ...refuse profane and old wives's fables, and exercise thyself rather to godliness. For bodily exercise profiteth little; but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. 1 Tim. 4:7-8

Fear-satan has fearful of man and what man can do to us. Do not be afraid is most quoted verse in the Bible. We need to distinguish between fear (being afraid) from Reverent fear of the Lord. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge. Proverbs 1:7

The very thing Job feared came upon him. I remember thinking, I wouldn't want my

son in the army. Guess where my son is? Right in the middle of the battle in Iraq. Satan causes so much oppression or possession due to fear. If you want to help someone, pray enough and read enough to believe God for them; otherwise if you fear for them you are not at all helping them-your are believing satan and helping satan work against them

DID you know the fearful and unbelieving are put with murderers and whoremongers in Rev. 21:8? But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

I will not <u>fear</u> what flesh can do unto me. Ps. 56:4.

But whosoever listens to me will dwell safely and will be secure without fear of evil. Proverbs 1:33.

I will <u>not be afraid</u> of ten thousands of people, that have set themselves around about me. Psalm 3:6

What time <u>I am afraid</u>, I will trust in thee. Psalm 56:3

In God, I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me. Psalm 56:4
The Lord is on my side; I will not fear, what can man do unto me? Psalm 118:6
Courage is fear that has said its prayers.
God tells his people over and over in the bible to be strong and courageous.

When <u>fear</u> knocks at your soul's door, send <u>faith</u> to answer.

Make us like Jesus! So we have to have the attributes of Jesus-<u>faith-not fear</u>.

mistrust-We trust what we can do, what others can do, but don't trust God; Satan has us trusting in something or someone other than God or what we can do. Our trust is misplaced. Or we believe God will harm us—afraid of what God himself will do to us.

Thus saith the Lord; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the Lord. Jeremiah 17:5

Worry- Troubled- Let your heart not be troubled, if you believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions, If it were not so I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you that where I am there you may be also. Be not far from me, O Lord; O my strength, haste thee to help me. Psalm 22:19

<u>Guilt-</u>The best way to handle our accusing enemy is to make our own confession. If we confess our sins, he is faithful to forgive

us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Satan wants us to stay under the weight of guilt even after God has forgiven us—living in the past.

Satan uses anything and everything he can to disable us in service to the LORDgoal is to make us ineffective and useless for the Kingdom of GOD and to destroy us anyway he can. (steals, kills and destroys) If satan is not bothering you, he already has you. Satan has us putting "Self" on the throne. It becomes all about me, my needs, my wants. Satan has us wallowing in self pity, self indulgence. We can either ignore self or ignore GOD. God must be first in order to be effective for the kingdom. Do you love him with all your heart mind soul and body? Any of the things we have talked about will make us ineffective in our prayer life and separate us from GOD so GOD does

not hear our prayers. Satan will do anything and everything to get our focus off of GOD so we become useless to God and so God will not help us.

Battle:

Recognize satan is real. He has a whole army of demons under his command. 1/3 of the angels. Better the devil we know than the devil we don't know. Their eyes were open and they knew HIM. When we know HIM, then we have the mind of Christ and spiritual discernment to recognize the devil and his tactics. Demon possession is real. Recognize trials and temptations will

always be a part of life.

Consider it pure joy, my brother whenever

Consider it pure joy, my brother whenever you face trials of many kinds because you know the testing of your faith develops perserverance. Perserverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and

complete, not lacking anything. James 1:2-4

Realize the spiritual battle is a fight for your life-abundant life here on earth and eternal life after this life is over.

Be aware of his tactics. He catches us unaware. He hides, hits slowly and subtly, in such a way you can't really see or identify him. HE uses guerilla warfarestrikes when you would least expect and in a way you would never dream and with the very person who you love most. When he gets you are in bondage and he can lead you wherever he wants.

Satan uses all of us at times to do his bidding.

Realize satan has no mercy-when it rains, it pours; strife and hurt everywhere we turn; The devil makes us think evil is good and good is evil. He often tries to bully us into silence.

Prepare for Battle-get your combat boots on:

1st step is to <u>Recognize the Battle is all</u> <u>about souls</u>: How do we win the war? Hit him where it hurts-the salvation of souls—Never win a war by dying in battle or being captured. You win when you get the other side on your side. When satan attacks you, attack back. Do something good for someone. Pray for others with same affliction you are suffering from. PUT ON THE WHOLE ARMOUR OF GOD to dispel all of the fiery darts of the enemy:

The helmet of salvation
The breastplate of righteousness-pure,
and upright before God, holy-sin
separates us from God-not a good
conscience-He won't hear us or answer
us. Clean hands and a pure heart.
The belt of truth
The sandals of peace
The shield of faith-Stand firm
The SWORD of the SPIRIT-THE
WORD.-And they overcame him by the

blood of the LAMB, and by the WORD of their testimony. Rev. 12:11. Jesus said to the devil it is written. We need to say to the devil it is written. God's WORD needs to become OUR WORD!

Weapons of warfare—
