Help (Verses Compiled By God and Karen Wilder)

O God, my <u>heart is fixed</u>: I will sing and give praise even with my glory. Psalm 8:1

They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture. But be not thou far from me O Lord: O my strength, haste thee to help

me. Deliver my soul from the sword; my darling from the power of the dog. Save me from the lion's mouth: for thou hast heard me from the horns of the unicorns.
